HOW THE TWO-STEP BSN PATHWAY WORKS

STEP 1: EARN YOUR ASSOCIATE'S DEGREE IN NURSING

Develop the knowledge and clinical skills to launch your career as an RN. You'll study nursing topics such as pathophysiology and pharmacology, and specialties including medical-surgical, maternal infant, pediatric, and mental health nursing. In addition, you'll complete a bachelor's-level course—Leadership and Management in the Changing Health Care Environment—which counts for credit toward both our ADN and BSN degrees. The program blends online coursework with on-ground lab, simulation, and clinical practice experiences.

STEP 2: EARN YOUR BACHELOR'S DEGREE IN NURSING ONLINE

Once enrolled in the BSN, you can customize your program with electives to prepare for certifications recognized by the Magnet Recognition Program®.[§] The clinical practice experience can be completed at a location of your choice.

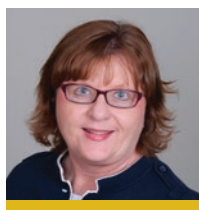
